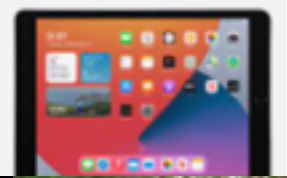

MY NATURE NAME

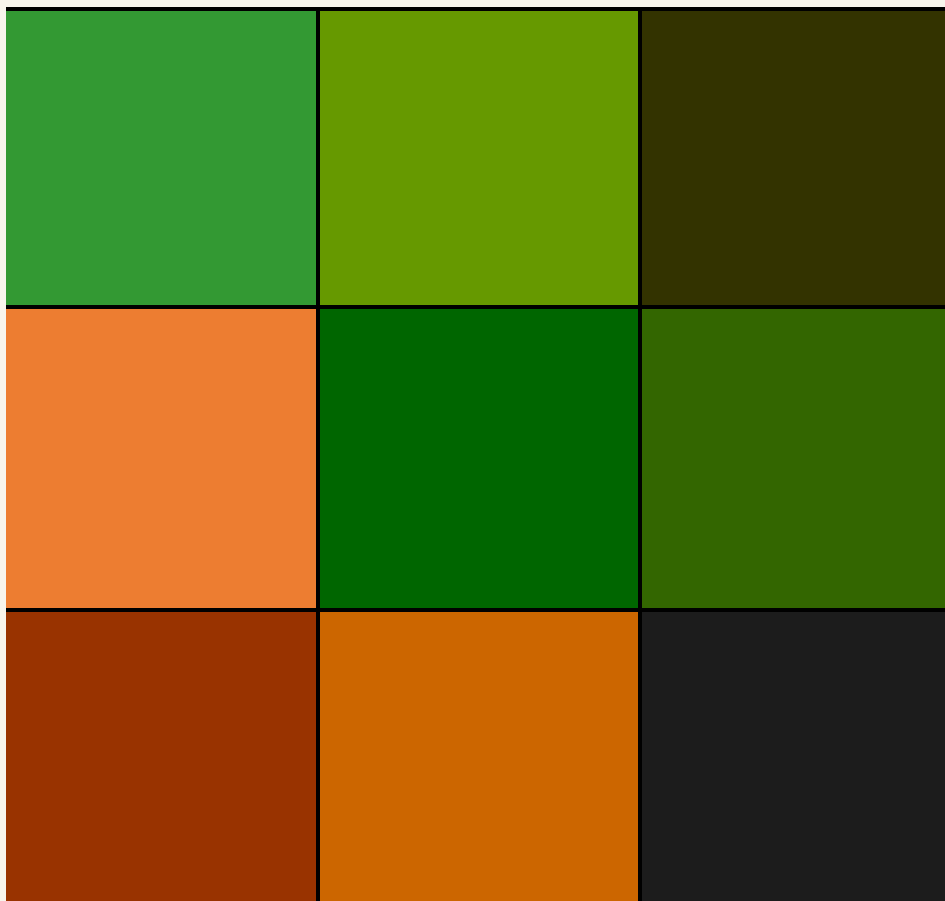

NATURE COLOUR HUNT



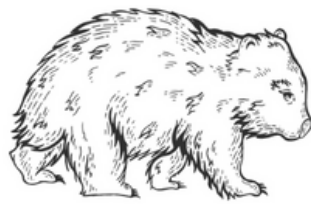
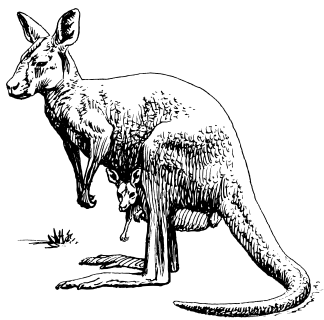
