<p>Environment</p> <p>Description: There is a risk of injury to a participant due to Environment</p>	<p>Causes: While lighting the fire</p> <p>Fire out of control</p> <p>Consequences Burns</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If it is not a requirement of the program Blackwood Staff will light the fire • All students must be sitting or at a safe distance from the fire pit when the fire is being lit. • Students will be taught how to correctly strike a match • Students MUST demonstrate how to strike a match • Strictly only one student Lighting the fire at any one time – other students MUST BE seated or at a safe distance from the fire pit • Once the Fire/s is/are lit no-one is allowed to move across or between fire pits – even if the pits are unused • ALL bush Cooking fires are kept to a minimum size at ALL times • CFA notified of date, time, location, group size & age of Bush Cooking Activity • Clear the Bush Cooking Site prior to groups arrival • Supervise students & fires at all time • Water available on site at all times 	Effective	Major	Rare	Medium				
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
